# 2026 Klondike Derby Registration Procedure

## February 6 or 7

Fees for the Klondike Derby.

- Scouts – \$10.00 Dollars per Sled Member.
- Scouters – \$5.00 Dollars (Patch)

Friday Night - Camping Check-in starting at 6 PM at Hart Dinning Hall

- Units must provide a roster at check-in no matter what.

Friday Night – Hart Dining Hall

- Sled Registration 8 – 9 PM
- Leaders Meeting 9 PM (2 Leaders and SPL)

Saturday - Hart Dining Hall

- Sled Registration and/or inspection 8 – 8:50 AM – Hart Dining Hall
- Unit Roster will be needed during Sled registration for those Units attending for Saturday Only.
- After Sled Registration, The Sled Patrol Leader will gather their patrol and prepare for Sled inspection behind the Camp Hart Dinning Hall.

Special Note:

- All Units **MUST** have current **MEDICAL** Forms for camping or coming for the day per BSA Policy.
- Medical forms stay with the Unit.
- **Sled Patrol Size** should be limited to 8 scouts. If you have 10 scouts, consider two patrols of 5.

Can Cub Scouts also attend GN Klondike? Only AOL Scouts may attend.

### **Sled Items:**

- 1 - Sled with or without wheels/tires
- 1 – First Aid Kit (will be using for a station)
- 1 – Trash bag
- 1 – BSA Scout Handbook
- Necessary items to cook a “HOT” lunch on trial for patrol (IE. Some type of stove to cook or boil water for lunch)
- 1 - Pencil or Pen
- 1 – Tarp (8”x10’ or larger)
- 1 – Whistle
- 20ft – Twine
- 8 - Stave minimum (5 or 6 feet long)
- 1 - Enough rope to do 10 lashings
- 1 – Notebook
- 2 – Brown Paper bags (large enough to go over head)
- 1 – Hand Saw, Bow Saw or Sierra Saw.
- 1 – Compass
- 1 – Fishing Pole (no hooks) and fishing weights
- 20– party balloons
- 1 – Some type of fire starter other than matches/lighter. ie, Flint & Steel or Steel wool/battery
- 1 - Kindling/tinder for fire
- 2–3-foot long 1/4" Rope.
- 1 – Klondike Patrol Totem or Flag – Must be shown at the start of each Station

### **Per Sled Member:**

- Boots, suitable outerwear. No sneakers or flipflops.
- Personal Mess Kit for lunch.
- Water bottle / Canteen
- Bandana/Neckerchief
- Pocketknife (Folding blade only)

7. When in doubt, see Rule #1.


## **CAMP RULES:**
